POLICIES

WHAT TO WEAR

Each camper will receive a camp shirt to be worn on all field trip days. Also, please make sure your child(ren) are in in cool, comfortable clothing with close toed shoes- no flip flops.

WHAT NOT TO WEAR

We appreciate you helping us enforce these rules. They have been carefully reviewed for both safey of all program participants and staff as well as to ensure the involvement of all the children in the program activities without distractions.

Please do not wear: halter tops, jeans, dark colored clothing, expensive clothing, items that promote tobacco, alcohol, vulgar slogans or innuendoes, dangle jewelty, two piece swimsuits, open toed shoes.

WHAT TO BRING

If your camper is bringing their lunch, please know that no microwave or refrigeration is available. Each day, your camper should bring a swim bag with a towel and swimsuit and sunscreen.

PLEASE MARK EVERY ITEM WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME!

WHAT NOT TO BRING

While we understand the importance of staying connected with each other, cell phones, iPods, iPads, handheld games and other electronic devices are not permitted at Camp Cheval, unless your camper is participating in a specialty camp. If a child does bring these items, they will be collected at the start of the camp day and given back to them at sign out.


SPECIALTY CAMP DROP OFF & PICK UP

Drop off for specialty/half day camps will begin 15 minutes prior to the camp starting. If your child is not with us for full day care, and participating in one of our tennis, aquatics or golf camps- drop off and pick up will occur at the program area. Please refer to the email sent by the director of each of those programs for more information.

If your child is participating in one of our Club specialty camps (not part of the full day care) drop off for all morning camps will be held in the carline at the Athletic Club. You can pick up your half day camper at 12pm from the lobby area of the Athletic Club. If your child is participating in an afternoon camp, please make sure they are dropped off at the Athletic Club lobby area at 11:45am and picked up in the same location at 4pm.

DROP OFF & PICK UP FOR CAMPERS WHO ARE HERE FOR FULL DAY CARE

For your convenience, we have a "Drive thru" drop off and pick up system. This will allow a fast and easy way to get in and out of the AC parking lot each day. Please see the map that will explain the flow of traffic during drop off (7:30-9am) and pick up (4pm-6:30pm) times. Please note, if we are experienceing inclement weather, all drop offs and pick ups will occur under the overhang at the front of the building.





SUNSCREEN

Camp Cheval does not provide sunscreen. Parents should apply sunscreen on the child before sending the child in the morning. Sunscreen breaks will be taken periodically. Children will apply sunscreen to themselves using their own sunscreen. As a last resort, staff may apply sunscreen, using the "bathing suit rule" which means that they will apply only to the areas that would not be covered by a one-piece swimsuit.



LITTLE STARS

Little Stars (Red Ball) Grades: Rising K-2nd

Weeks: Offered all 10 weeks *except Week 6

Time: 9a-11a

Cost per Week: \$160 Members/ \$180 Non-Members

Using Red Balls and the 36' court the goal is to learn the fundamentals in a positive and fun environment. Our Coaches run drills and games that develop basic ball striking skills, hand eye coordination and movement as we introduce tennis to our Little Stars.

Hot Shots (Orange Ball) Grades: Rising 3rd-6th

Weeks: Offered all 10 Weeks *except Week 6

Time: 9a-12p

Cost per Week: \$235 Members/ \$265 Non-Members

Using Orange Balls and the 60' court kids will learn the correct technique for tennis strokes and work on rallying progressions. Using fun drills and games, we will work on hand eye coordination, movement and teach kids how to play the game. Kids will be split by level of play and experience.

GET STARTED. MOVE ON. LEVEL UP.

RED BALL

The tennis journey starts with the red level. Red balls can be made of foam or felt, are larger, bounce lower and travel slower than the standard yellow ball making it easier to learn and acquire skills.




Orange balls travel through the air a little faster and farther than the red ball, but are the same size and still bounce lower than a yellow ball.



GREEN & YELLOW BALLS


Green balls have a slightly reduced bounce compared to the yellow ball making the transition to a full-size 78' court much easier.






COURT SIZE: 36' x 18'

Red Courts are short and narrow, making it easy for players to focus on learning the fundamentals of the game.



COURT SIZE: 60' x 21' - 0R - 60' x 27' (DOUBLES)

Slightly smaller than the full-size 78' court, Orange Courts are ideal for players who are still developing their athletic, technical, and competitive skills.



COURT SIZE: 78' x 27' - OR - 78' x 36' (DOUBLES)

At this stage, while continuing to improve their tactical and technical skills, a player's size does not hinder their ability to cover a full-size tennis court.





Level: Intermediate & Advanced (Limit 8 Kids)

Ages: 8-15 years old

Weeks: Offered all 10 Weeks *except Weeks 6 & 10

Afternoons 1p-4p

Cost per Week: \$160 Members/ \$185 Non-Members

This camp will be a supervised, on-course playing camp (the goal will be for campers to play 9-holes every day). Counselors and/or Instructors will accompany the campers out on the course for a daily playing experience (campers will be walking a lot!). Players Club will be a great way for young golfers looking to take their games to the next level to get plenty of playing experience. If weather dictates (rain threatens or excessive heat), Players Club will happen in the Grail on the Flightscope simulators.
